

What's the difference between NaturalReader Online and NaturalReader Software?

1) Accessibility – NaturalReader Online is an online application that you can login and use at any time from any computer with an internet connection. There are two subscription plans available: Web Premium and Web Premium Plus.

The NaturalReader software versions (Personal, Professional, and Ultimate) are downloadable software that must be installed onto your computer's hard drive. A CD copy can also be ordered with an additional shipping fee. Each software license is meant for use for one computer only. However, if it is only for your own use on your own personal computers, you may install it on up to 2 machines.

The NaturalReader software is able to function offline in all functions and features except for the OCR feature, which requires an internet connection to work. More information about OCR is listed below under 'Additional Features'.

2) Pricing – NaturalReader Web is a subscription requiring annual billing. There are 2 subscription plans available:

Web Premium (\$4.99/ month – billed annually)

Web Premium Plus (\$7.99/ month – billed annually)

The software versions are a one-time payment for a perpetual license:

Personal (\$69.50)

Professional (\$129.50)

Ultimate (\$199.50)

3) Voices – NaturalReader Web's Premium Plan allows you access to all 57 online voices. The software versions come with a set amount of HD voices, depending on the version:

Personal – 2 voices

Professional – 4 voices

Ultimate – 6 voices

Additional voices can be purchased for the software for \$39.50 each. The voice selection for the software versions is also slightly different—you can view a full list of the voices available from this page: <https://www.naturalreaders.com/voicelist.html>

Note: Voices available for Mac may also differ. Please scroll down about halfway on the page in the link above to begin viewing Mac voices

4) Updates – As an online application, NaturalReader Web is always up to date. We periodically release software updates for the software, the most recent of which was version 15 released in July 2017. Software updates are optional, costing \$49.50 and comes with a free voice.

Regarding our policies for the software, please keep in mind that our customers are responsible for creating their own backup files for reinstallation, if needed. At the time of purchase, you can

opt to order a CD copy of the software for an additional \$9.95 shipping fee. As NaturalReader continues to release updates to the software, older versions are no longer made available to purchase/re-download. For security reasons, the download links we provide to you after purchase expire after 180 days. Customers who require new download links after they expire and do not have a backup CD to reinstall from must purchase the \$49.50 update to receive new links. This update includes the most recent version of the software as well as one complimentary voice of your choosing.

5) Additional Features – The software versions contain additional features. Included in all versions is the Floating Bar, which allows you to read aloud from other applications, such as MS Word, or webpages from a browser. The Professional and Ultimate versions for Windows, also includes Conversation Control and the Batch File Converter. With XML tags, you can change the speaker, speed, or add strategic pauses. The Batch File Converter allows you to create multiple mp3 files at once. Conversation Control and the Batch Converter are available on the Windows versions of Professional and Ultimate only.

OCR (Optical Character Recognition)

OCR (optical character recognition) functions by scanning images of text and converting that information into a machine-encoded digitized text which can then be interpreted and read aloud by a speech synthesizer, such as NaturalReader.

The OCR feature is available with the Professional and Ultimate software versions, as well as the Web Premium Plus online subscription plan. It is limited for use for up to 500 images for the Professional version. The Ultimate version and Premium Plus account both come with unlimited access to this feature.

These limits are lifetime limits; they cannot be reset. In order access this feature once the limit is reached, you would have to upgrade to a higher version of the software/subscription plan.

Text to Downloadable Audio Files*

All 3 of the paid software versions permits unlimited conversion of text to downloadable audio files, which are permitted for personal use only.

The NaturalReader Online plans are limited for mp3 conversion, with the Web Premium plan allowing up to 1 000 000 characters to be converted per subscription term. Web Premium Plus allows up to 5 000 000 characters per term. The NaturalReader Online applications are also permitted for personal use only.

*Note: The Mac software versions can only convert the audio files to Apple's .aiff file format, which can be converted to mp3 or WAV using iTunes. The Windows versions and online applications export the audio in mp3 format only.
